(REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR 1902)

TO HIS EXCELLENCE THE GOVERNOR,—

The Trustees of the Australian Museum have the honour to submit to your Excellency their Forty-ninth Annual Report.

1. There have been no changes in the membership of the Board during the year.
2. Parliament having voted funds for the engagement of a second Mechanical Assistant to the Curator, Mr. Alan McCulloch was appointed to the post.
3. The Museum continued open to visitors during the usual hours, viz., from 2 to 5 p.m. on Sundays, and from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on all week-days, except Mondays, which were reserved for cleaning purposes; but on Monday afternoons the collections were, as usual, accessible to students and schools for teaching purposes, on application being made to the Curator. The total number of visitors recorded is 147,290, showing a decrease of 19,386 for the year. The average was 404 (469 the previous year) on week-days, and 780 (834 the previous year) on Sundays. The largest attendance on any one day occurred on the 8th October, when 2,252 persons entered the building.
4. The Trustees again regret to have to call attention to the statement made in last year's Report, viz., that "The ordinary income available for the general purposes of the Institution has remained, practically, at the same figure as in former years, an amount far from sufficient to enable the Trustees to keep the Australian Museum in a state of efficiency." In consequence of the incessant activity of European Governments and wealthy British collectors in purchasing objects of natural history in Australasia, it becomes, from year to year, more and more difficult for this Museum, with the means available, to maintain its position as the leading scientific institution of its kind in the Commonwealth.

With the concurrence of the Minister for Public Instruction, the Museum estimates were re-arranged and simplified, all the salaries being now voted by Parliament, the maintenance charges paid from the endowment, and some necessary expenses voted as contingencies.

5. The acquisition of specimens continues to be dependent mainly on donations, supplemented by small purchases, by exchanges with other museums and with private collectors, and by collections, the result of voluntary efforts on the part of members of the Museum staff and correspondents. Details of the number of specimens so acquired will be found in Appendix IV.

The Curator having had an opportunity of accompanying Professor T. W. E. David and Mr. E. F. Pittman, Government Geologist, with the authority of the Board, on a visit to the country around Yass, for the purpose of geologically examining the neighbourhood, the result was the acquisition of fossil organic remains new to the Museum collection.

6. In the recently-erected portion of the new south wing cases have been erected, as far as the sum voted by Parliament would allow, for the reception of the ethnological collection, and some of the cases from the old Ethnological Hall have been re-erected temporarily therein. The ethnological collection has been re-arranged to the best possible advantage in the upper half gallery of this wing. The Trustees have already, in last year's Report, called attention to the fact that the old Ethnological Hall has been condemned as a structure, and was ready to be pulled down, but, so far, no attempt has been made to remove it. No further permanent progress can be made with the arrangement of the collections, nor can the galleries in this wing be properly utilised, until these necessary extensions and improvements have been effected.

7. The additions to the library number 409 volumes, besides pamphlets and unbound parts of periodicals. A list of these is given in Appendix VII.

8. The preparation of the new addition of Mr. J. A. North's work "Nests and Eggs of Birds found breeding in Australia and Tasmania" has been continued. The second part was issued in April.
