TO HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR,—

The Trustees of the Australian Museum have the honor to submit to your Excellency their Fifty-second Report, for the year ended 30th June, 1906.

1. There were no changes during the year among the Trustees, but Dr. G. E. Rundle and Professor T. W. E. David were granted leave of absence.

2. Among the Staff the following changes have taken place:—Mr. E. R. Waite, Assistant in Zoology, resigned on 31st March, having been appointed Curator of the Canterbury Museum, Christchurch, New Zealand. The position of Zoologist had not been filled at 30th June.

Mr. R. Barnes, Artificer, died on the 13th March after a service with the Trustees extending over forty years. Mr. B. Lucas, Carpenter, was appointed to fill the vacancy. Mr. T. Henson, Night Attendant, was appointed Carpenter, and a new Night Attendant was engaged.

3. The Museum continued open to visitors during the usual hours, viz., from 2 to 5 p.m. on Sundays, and from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on all week-days, except Mondays, which latter were reserved for cleaning purposes; but on Monday afternoons the collections were, as usual, accessible to students and schools for teaching purposes, on application being made to the Curator. The total number of visitors recorded during 1905 was 135,418. The average was 397 on week-days, and 555 on Sundays. The largest attendance on any one day occurred on the 2nd October, when 3,252 persons entered the building.

Advantage has been taken of the "Students' Days" on Monday afternoons, students and scholars, with their teachers, to the number of 285 persons, or an average of 29, having visited the Museum for study each Monday during the season.

4. The Gallery Demonstrations, which were commenced last year, have been continued, and been well attended. They are intended primarily for Public School Teachers and Students, but owing to the small accommodation the admission has to be limited by ticket.

The establishment and success of these "Demonstrations" has again forcibly brought before the Trustees the great desirability of the addition of a properly equipped Lecture Theatre to the Institution under their control. No room in the present range of buildings is suitable for the delivery of lectures,

but were such the case, it would enable the Trustees to institute courses of both an elementary and advanced nature, and the Trustees are of opinion that an aid to instruction of this character would prove highly popular.

5. The acquisition of specimens continues to be dependent on donations; on exchange with other museums and with private collectors; on collections, the result of voluntary efforts on the part of members of the Museum Staff and correspondents; and on purchases, so far as funds will permit. Details of the number of specimens so acquired will be found in Appendix IV. But systematic collecting has not been carried out for want of funds.

The "Roth" Collection of North Queensland Ethnological specimens, the acquisition of which was referred to in the last Report, was arranged temporarily for inspection, and the fact announced in the daily Press. A good many visitors took advantage of the opportunity to inspect it.

Four very valuable and extensive collections—two of minerals, one of insects, and a large Ethnological series—were offered to the Trustees, but the funds for acquiring them were not available.

The Trustees desire to point out how very undesirable it is to allow collections—often well-known and of special value to the State—to pass out of it irrevocably, when by a simple process of combination amongst the State Departments interested, the collections in question could be acquired at a reasonable cost, and subdivided amongst the various Metropolitan and Country Museums.

6. The opportunity of an expedition organised by Prof. T. W. E. David to Mount Kosciusko was taken advantage of to send Mr. Charles Hedley on behalf of the Museum. Besides surface collecting, dredging in the Blue Lake was carried out, and both valuable information and new specimens were obtained. The results will be published elsewhere.

7. It affords the Trustees great pleasure to report that the National Collection under their control continues to be maintained in an excellent state of preservation. At the same time, the Trustees desire to emphasise the fact that no further advance from an exhibition, and therefore popular, point of view can be made until the Museum is extended. Not only is the space devoted to exhibition purposes overcrowded, but the store-rooms are filled with specimens, often of a highly valuable nature, waiting to be displayed. In the words of the late Dr. G. Brown Goode, M.A., LL.D., Assistant Secretary, Smithsonian Institution, Washington, "A finished museum is a dead museum, and a dead museum is a useless museum."

8. The Government of New South Wales ordered an inquiry to be conducted by the Public Service Board into the management of the Scientific Institutions of the State, with a view to more thorough efficiency and economy. The assistance of the Trustees was requested, and in consequence the President and the Curator were authorised to represent them on committees. The inquiry is not yet completed.
