(REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE, 1908.)

TO HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR,—

The Trustees of the Australian Museum have the honor to submit to your Excellency their Fifty-fourth Report, being for the year ended 30th June, 1908.

1. The Trustees regret having to report the resignation of Professor A. Liversidge, M.A., LL.D., F.R.S., &c., on his leaving Australia. He had been a Trustee of the Australian Museum for thirty-four years, having been elected in 1874, and his advice and assistance were highly esteemed. The vacancy thus caused was filled by the election of Col. W. L. Vernon, Government Architect.

Professor T. W. E. David and Dr. R. E. Roth were granted leave of absence during part of the year.

A list of the Trustees, with records of their attendance during the year 1907, will be found in Appendix II.

2. Mr. T. Whitelegge, one of the Scientific Assistants, was granted six months' leave of absence on account of ill-health, and at the close of the term resigned his position. He had been connected with the Museum for twenty-four years, and has done excellent work. The vacancy has not yet been filled.

Mr. J. A. Thorpe, Taxidermist, died on 5th August, 1907, and Mr. Robert Grant, Assistant Taxidermist, was promoted to the vacant post. Mr. Thorpe held his position in the Museum for thirty-eight years, having been appointed in 1869. Many of the specimens and all the groups in the Museum bear testimony to the excellence and beauty of his work.

Other minor changes have also been made in the staff. It has been decided to engage young men as assistants to the Scientific Staff with a view to training them for the future. The salary offered is small, but the training and education they receive are considered ample compensation, but it is hoped means will be found to remunerate them more highly as they become proficient. They are to be styled "Cadets," and six appointments have been made.

In view of the rapid growth of the Museum and the increased duties and responsibilities falling on the Trustees and their officers, and seeing that in a few months a large addition now in course of erection will be handed over to them, the Trustees consider the time has come when an Assistant Curator should be appointed. They hope to accomplish this during the coming year.

A Committee of the Trustees has examined the members of the staff as to their duties and efficiency, and made recommendations which will be given effect to as soon as possible.

A list of the Museum staff, with the positions held by them, will be found in Appendix VII.

3. The Museum continued open to visitors during the usual hours, viz., from 2 to 5 p.m. on Sundays, and from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on all week-days, except Mondays, which latter were reserved for cleaning purposes; but on Monday afternoons the collections were, as usual, accessible to students and schools for teaching purposes, on application being made to the Curator. The total number of visitors recorded during 1907 was 173,762. The average was 532 on week-days and 638 on Sundays. The largest attendance on any one day occurred on the 7th October, when 2,081 persons entered the building.

Advantage has been taken of the Monday afternoons by students and scholars, who, with their teachers to the number of 1,342 persons, visited the Museum for study on these afternoons.

4. Two of the Zoologists (Messrs. C. Hedley and A. R. McCulloch) were granted leave of absence to undertake an expedition to Torres Straits. They visited Murray Island and other localities, and secured extensive and valuable collections both of natural history and ethnology, which are now in course of being worked out in the Museum. There will be some results new to science, reports of which will be published in the "Records of the Australian Museum."

Mr. W. W. Thorpe, a member of the staff, also spent a short time collecting at a fossiliferous bed in the mountains near Bundanoon, and obtained for the Museum a most interesting series of Permo-Carboniferous fossils.

5. The gallery lectures and demonstrations for teachers and students have been continued. There is not at present accommodation to make these available for the general public, and they are therefore prepared only for teachers and students. Tickets for public school teachers are distributed through the Department of Public Instruction; private school teachers and students receive tickets from the Secretary of the Museum on application.

In addition to these lectures for teachers, the Trustees have resolved to institute an examination or series of examinations for children, with a view both to interesting them in the natural history of their country and of making the Museum better known. These cannot be given effect to until the new Lecture Hall is ready, but preparations will be made and the scheme announced when ready.

6. The acquisition of specimens is maintained by means of donations, exchanges, collections—the result of the efforts of the staff and of correspondents—and purchases, so far as funds will permit. Among the most noticeable are:—

A large and very fine collection of Minerals, mostly Australian, purchased from Mr. Geo. Smith.

A general series of about 2,500 Exotic Insects from the collection of the late Mr. Jas. Kershaw, of Melbourne.

An interesting series of specimens representing North American Ethnology, from the Toronto Museum.

A Maori Feather Cloak from New Zealand, in good preservation.

A collection of over 2,000 coins, representing the coinage of many countries, purchased from Mr. E. J. Redman.

A collection of Australian Copper Tokens.

A number of interesting Mammals and Birds from German New Guinea, forwarded by a correspondent; and a collection of remarkable ancient pottery from South-east British New Guinea, presented by Mr. P. J. Money, Anglican lay missionary.

Details of the number of specimens acquired during the year 1907 will be found in Appendix IV.

7. In connection with the new Commonwealth Tariff and its bearing on Museum aims and requirements, the Trustees are pleased to say that representations made by them, as well as by other Museum authorities in Australia, have been effective, and under the revised Tariff specimens of natural history, and, to some extent, goods for Museum purposes are to be admitted duty free.

8. The Trustees are pleased to report that the collections continue to be maintained in good order, although the congested state of the Museum prevents their public display to full advantage. Parliament having voted the necessary funds, operations for the erection of a much needed extension were commenced in April last. This will form a continuation of the South Wing, connecting it with the main Museum buildings, and will provide two large galleries for the Ethnological and Mammalian Collections as well as some additional workrooms, a Lecture Hall, and other facilities.

9. The Trustees have devoted considerable attention to a revision of their "By-Laws, Rules and Orders." The new code received the approval of His Excellency the Governor on 9th April, 1908, and is now in operation.

10. The library continues to increase rapidly, and additional space is much required for the erection of more bookcases. The additions during the year numbered 987 volumes, besides unbound parts of periodicals and pamphlets. The printing of the Library Card Catalogue is being proceeded with as opportunity offers. The number of Catalogue slips and cards printed is 1,745.
