(REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE, 1909.)

To His EXCELLENCE THE GOVERNOR,—

The Trustees of the Australian Museum have the honor to submit to your Excellency their Fifty-fifth Report, being for the year ended 30th June, 1909.

1. TRUSTEES.

Professor T. W. E. David, B.A., F.R.S., who, last year, was granted leave of absence owing to his having accompanied the National Antarctic Expedition, has resumed his seat as a Trustee. The Trustees regret having to record the death of the late Hon. Sir Arthur Renwick, M.D., K.B., M.L.C., who was an official Trustee as President of the Medical Board. His successor is Sir Phillip Sydney Jones, M.D., F.R.C.S. A list of the Trustees, with records of their attendance during the year 1908, will be found in Appendix II.

2. STAFF.

Parliament having granted a sum for an Assistant Curator, the appointment was conferred on Mr. Charles Hedley, Conchologist, who has been connected with the Museum for eighteen years. It was understood that besides the Sub-Curatorial duties, whoever obtained the position would be expected to undertake the charge of one of the special scientific sections of the Museum; Mr. Hedley, accordingly, continues on the Scientific Staff as Conchologist.

The vacancy caused by the retirement of Mr. T. Whitelegge, last year, was held open until the appointment of the Assistant Curator was settled. In the meantime, Mr. T. Harvey Johnston, M.A., B.Sc., was engaged as a temporary Assistant, to overtake necessary work. Mr. Edward F. Hallmann, B.Sc., has been definitely appointed to the vacant post as Scientific Assistant in Lower Invertebrate Zoology, Mr. A. R. McCulloch, in addition to his duties in Vertebrate Zoology, undertakes the Crustacea; and Mr. T. H. Johnston has been appointed Hon. Zoologist to work out the Annelida, Entozoa, and other lower groups. Dr. E. P. Ramsay, who held the position of Curator from 1874 to 1894, and who retained his connection with the Museum afterwards as "Consulting Ornithologist," collecting and preparing catalogues, finally left the service of the Trustees in February last.

The determination of the Board of Trustees to engage "Cadets," mentioned in last year's Report, has proved satisfactory. There are now seven lads holding these positions, and it has been made a condition that they attend the Zoological or Mineralogical classes at the Technical College, and by way of a stimulus the fees of those who pass examinations and obtain certificates will be refunded. It has been arranged also that they go out collecting occasionally in the neighbourhood of Sydney under the supervision of one or other of the Scientific Assistants.

Senior Attendant S. Long retired from the Trustees' service on 12th October, 1908, owing to ill-health. He had been in the Museum for seventeen years, and previous to that he had been in responsible positions under the British Government and Government of New South Wales, making a record in the Public Service of about fifty years, with good conduct. Mrs. Dashwood, one of the female attendants, retired after twenty-seven years' service. Owing to these changes and the need for more assistance, arising from taking over the new buildings, several additional attendants have been engaged, and Warrant Officer J. Cronin, late of the Royal Australian Artillery, has been appointed Chief Attendant.

3. VISITORS.

The Museum continued open throughout the year during the usual hours, viz., on week-days (Mondays excepted) from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., and on Sundays from 2 to 5 p.m. The number of visitors recorded on week-days was 174,336, averaging 665, and on Sundays 45,438, averaging 874 per day, making a total of 219,774. On Mondays, except when a public holiday falls on that day, the Museum is closed for cleaning, but in the afternoon students and pupils of public and private schools, with their teachers, are admitted, and are given facilities for study and teaching. These opportunities are increasingly taken advantage of, 829 persons having visited the Museum on Monday afternoons for study. Teachers frequently bring their classes on ordinary visiting days for instruction.

Details of the monthly Returns for Attendance will be found in Appendix III.

4. LECTURES.

Lectures for Teachers began in 1905, and have been continued monthly on Saturday forenoons. Owing to the limited accommodation it has not been possible to make these as efficient as the Trustees desire, as they had to be held in whatever room or vacant place might be available at the time. A new Lecture Theatre will, however, be ready shortly—probably before this Report is printed and distributed—when the Trustees hope to make the Lectures a prominent feature of Museum study.

A Syllabus of the Lectures delivered since last Report, with those in preparation, will be found in Appendix VII.

5. ACQUISITIONS.

The collections in the Museum continue to be maintained in good order, and are constantly being added to by means of donations, purchases, and exchanges with other Museums.

Amongst the most noticeable additions during the past year are :—

Splendid examples of the rare shells *Voluta hednalli* and *Voluta roadknighti*.

A fine series of Native Weapons from South Africa.

A number of enlarged models of animals showing the structure, to be used for lecture purposes.

Some fine specimens of Topaz, Gold Tellurides, and other minerals.

Ethnological specimens from New Guinea, the Pacific Islands, and Australia.

A small collection of Humming Birds.

A summary of the acquisitions will be found in Appendix IV.

6. BUILDINGS.

The new buildings erected by the Government are now finished, and were handed over to the Trustees on the 14th June, 1909. The addition fills up a gap between the already erected portion of the South Wing and the main Museum building facing College-street, making one continuous series. The whole consists of two floors and a basement. The upper floor is in two fine halls, with glass roof supported by columns and separated by a wide arch; these will contain the Ethnological Collections, among which the Australian portion will receive a prominent display. The Ground Floor is similar to that above, but is lit by side windows; a portion at least is intended for Mammals and Skeletons of Mammals, of which the Australian specimens will be made conspicuous. The total length of each floor, including both the old and new sections, is 220 feet, and when fully furnished they will make magnificent vistas. Cases are in course of erection for the reception of exhibits on both floors.

The new Lecture Hall is situated on the Ground Floor and will seat 250 persons. It is to be fitted with every convenience for lecture purposes, including a modern demonstrator's lantern.

Opening off the same floors are the lavatories and retiring rooms for visitors.

The new portion of the Basement contains workrooms for the Curator, the Mineralogist, and the Printer, a dressing room for the Attendants, and lavatory for the Museum Staff.

In Appendix IX will be found photographic views of the two new halls in their present condition, showing the work of exhibition case-building in progress.

7. LIBRARY.

The number of books of reference in the Library is much increased, in fact faster than accommodation can be found for them. During the year 1908 the additions numbered 756 volumes, irrespective of unbound periodicals and pamphlets. The printing of the Catalogue of books has not made much progress owing to the Museum printer's time being fully occupied with other necessary work, but the checking of the Library slips in manuscript is steadily continued. The number of catalogue slips and cards printed during 1908 was 424.

8. PUBLICATIONS.

The Museum publications issued since last Report and now in preparation are :—

Special Catalogue No. 1, "Nests and Eggs of Birds," by A. J. North, Vol. II, Part 3, is in the press, and will shortly be ready for distribution.
