Streamwatch Site/s: We monitor 3 sites across peri-urban north-western Sydney, one on Charltons Creek and two on Still Creek, in the suburbs of Galston, Arcadia and Berrilee.

Why did you join Streamwatch? Barry: To help preserve the good condition of the catchment over time; measuring water quality at the top and bottom of the catchment gives an excellent and convenient indication of the catchment condition.

Chris: Streamwatch exemplifies the scientific data based approach applied to care for the globally deteriorating physical environment.

Highpoints of Streamwatch involvement:

Being able to demonstrate that our data showed that pollution in the region did not appear to be originating in this sub-catchment, thus enabling investigation to be directed elsewhere.

Data analysis over the last 9 years shows no deterioration in water quality, despite progressive changes in land usage and siltation from residential developments.

Challenges: Leeches and ticks!
