(REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR 1901.)

TO HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR,—

The Trustees of the Australian Museum have the honor to submit to your Excellency their Forty-eighth Annual Report.

1. The Trustees regret to have to record the death of the Hon. S. H. Hyam, one of the Elective Trustees, who occupied a seat on the Board from 3rd April, 1894. Mr. Hugh Pollock, another of the Elective Trustees, having been appointed Solicitor-General, resigned his seat and became an Official Trustee under the Act of Incorporation. The vacancies thus caused were filled by the election of G. E. Rundle, Esq., F.R.C.S., Edin., and W. H. Hargraves, Esq.

Continued leave of absence was granted to Col. W. D. Campbell Williams, C.B., P.M.O., for part of the year, owing to his absence in South Africa and in England. The President, James C. Cox, Esq., M.D., was also absent on leave for a portion of the year, during which he represented the Trustees at the Meeting of the Museums Association in Edinburgh.

2. Mr. T. Cooksey, B.Sc., Ph.D., Mineralogist, having resigned some time back, the Trustees were fortunate in securing his services as Consulting Mineralogist, with the concurrence of the Public Service Board, and of the Department of Public Health, where he is now employed, until the 30th June last, when his engagement with the Trustees finally terminated. The vacancy has been filled by the appointment to the position of Mineralogist of Mr. Charles Anderson, M.A., B.Sc., late of the Ben Nevis Observatory.

3. The Museum continued open to visitors during the usual hours, viz., from 2 to 5 p.m. on Sundays, and from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on all week-days, except Mondays, which were reserved for cleaning purposes; but on Monday afternoons the collections were, as usual, accessible to students and schools for teaching purposes on application being made to the Curator. The total number of visitors recorded is 166,676, showing an increase of 49,749 for the year. The average was 469 (325 the previous year) on week-days, and 834 (601 the previous year) on Sundays. The largest attendance on any one day occurred during the Commonwealth Celebrations, on the 2nd January, when 2,142 persons entered the building; and on the 28th May, during the visit of H.R.H. the Duke of Cornwall and York, 2,013 persons entered. The large increase mentioned was no doubt due to the influx of visitors during both of these holiday times.

4. The ordinary income available for the general purposes of the Institution has remained, practically, at the same figure as in former years—an amount far from sufficient to enable the Trustees to keep the Australian Museum in a proper state of efficiency, and maintain it in its proper place in the first rank of the Scientific Institutions of the Commonwealth. By reason of the inadequacy of income the Trustees have hitherto been prevented from carrying out much-needed schemes, such as the appointment of a Collector, the extension of the Library, the purchase of specimens, and other matters urgently required to keep the Institution abreast of the times.

5. The acquisition of specimens is at present dependent mainly on donations, supplemented by purchases, exchanges with other Museums and with private collectors, and by collections made voluntarily by members of the Museum Staff and other friends. Details of the number of specimens so acquired will be found in Appendix IV. The Trustees are indebted to Mr. Charles Hedley, one of the Scientific Assistants, for a large collection of Sponges, Mollusca, Corals, &c., made by him during a holiday trip to the North Queensland coast, and presented to the Museum.

6. The half of the South Wing recently erected was handed over by the contractor in April last, and is now being fitted with cases as far as the funds available will permit. A sum of £1,000 was asked, but only £500 were voted, for this purpose. This sum will case approximately only one-half of the Upper Floor, that is, one-fourth of the whole. As soon as the new cases are ready the Ethnological Collection will be removed from the Ethnological Hall, which, having been already condemned as a structure, will then be ready to be pulled down and the ground cleared for the completion of the new South Wing. No further permanent progress can be made with the arrangement of the Collections, nor can the galleries in the South Wing be properly utilised, until these necessary extensions and improvements shall have been effected.

7. The additions to the Library number 566 volumes, besides pamphlets and unbound parts of periodicals. A list of these is given in Appendix VII.

8. The preparation of the new edition of Mr. A. J. North's work has been continued. It is practically new, although to some extent based on the former Catalogue, and it has been decided to call it "Special Catalogue, No. 1, Nests and Eggs of Birds found breeding in Australia and Tasmania." The first part was issued in June.
